1. Global Major Ship Recycling Industry News Update of This Week

- i. South Asia continued dominating global ship recycling activity with India and Bangladesh remaining major destinations.
- ii. Discussions continued regarding Hong Kong Convention implementation and environmentally compliant recycling practices.
- iii. Strong freight earnings in certain shipping sectors continued limiting demolition supply of younger vessels.
- iv. European environmental groups continued emphasizing stricter global recycling compliance and transparency.
- v. Increased attention remained on sanctioned and shadow fleet vessels entering recycling markets.

2. Indian Major Ship Recycling Industry News Update of This Week

- i. Alang yards continued witnessing moderate activity in tankers, offshore units, and chemical carriers.
- ii. Current AlangToday data indicates approximately 76 working ships and demolished tonnage exceeding 6 lakh LDT.
- iii. Discussions continued regarding BIS-related flexibility and operational support for recyclers.
- iv. Imported scrap prices and vessel availability remained closely monitored by industry participants.
- v. Green recycling compliance and yard modernization remained major priorities.

3. Global Major Steel Industry News Update of This Week

- i. Iron ore and raw material prices remained volatile due to Chinese demand sentiment and Guinea developments.
- ii. US and European steel associations continued discussions on tariffs and excess steel capacities.
- iii. Investments in green steel, DR-grade iron ore, and electric arc furnace projects continued globally.
- iv. Geopolitical developments and trade tensions continued influencing commodity and freight markets.
- v. Infrastructure and energy-transition sectors continued supporting global steel demand.

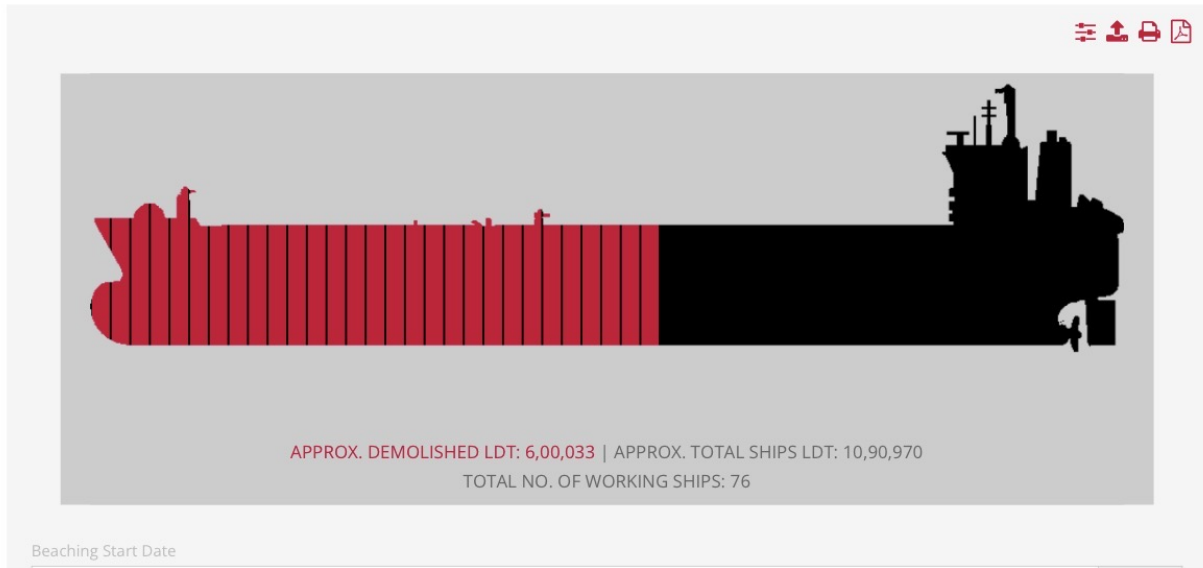
4. Indian Major Steel Industry News Update of This Week

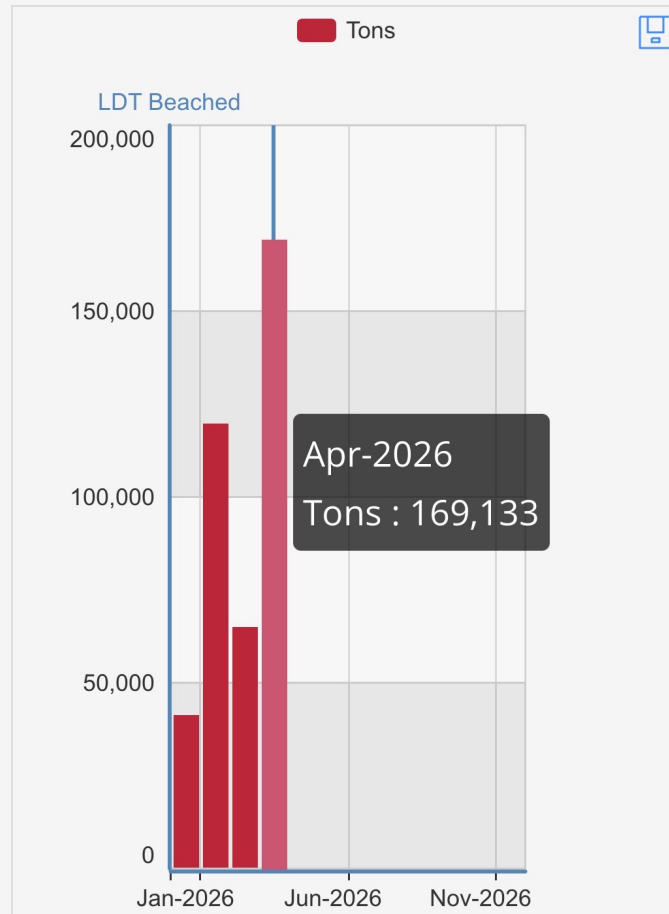

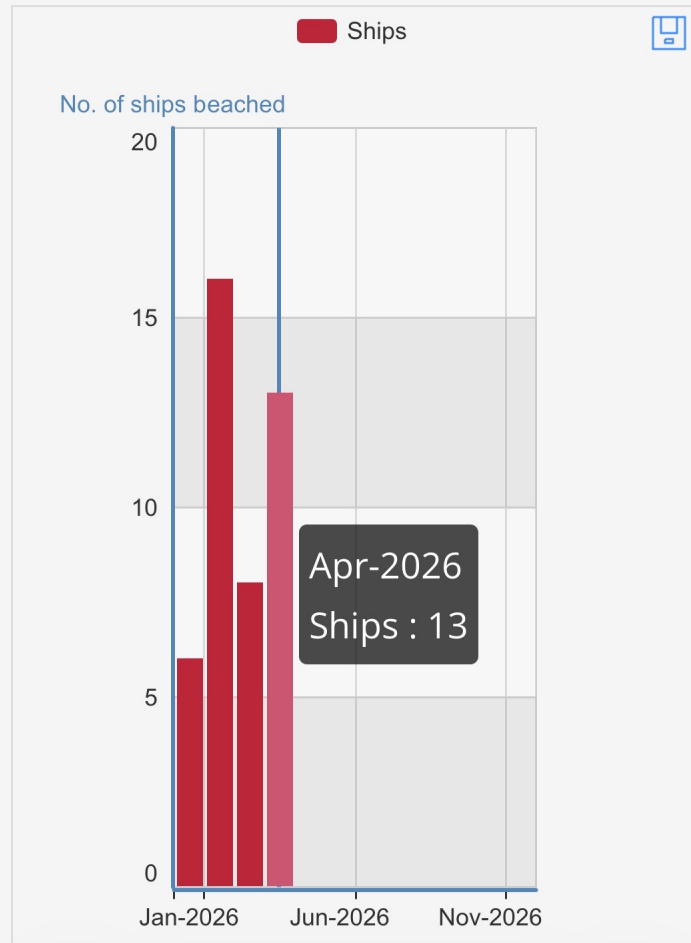

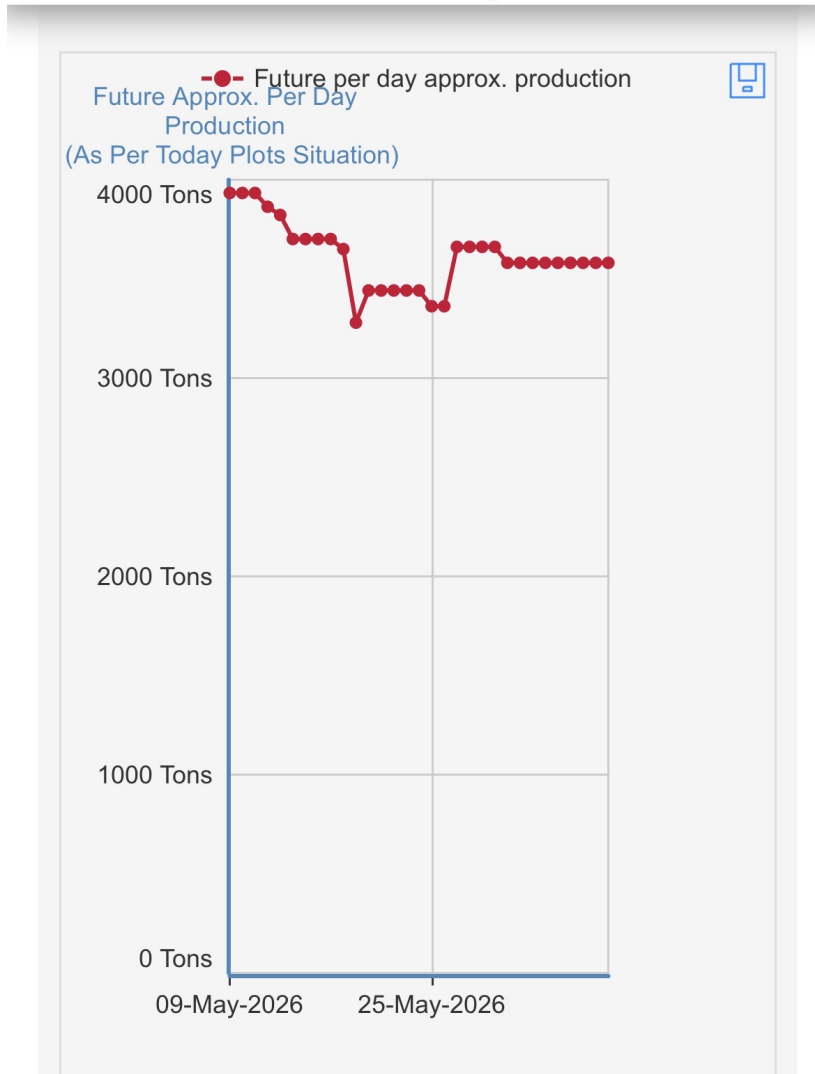
